My Call, My Faith, and my Car Payment

Parsons will explore the nature of call in our vocations. How healthy is your call today and does it have its own energy? What role does your faith journey play in your call? We will explore how the peaks and valleys of faith impact vocation. Finally the reality check of living out your call while meeting the needs of room and board.



Rev. Gradye Parsons was ordained 37 years ago as a Presbyterian teaching elder. His first job in the church was as a janitor. "It's been a privilege for me to serve," he said. "All of my jobs in

the church have been a pleasure to me." Gradye was the Stated Clerk of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) General Assembly when he announced in August 2015 that he would not stand for election to a third four-year term as the highest elected officer of the church. Parsons previously served pastorates in Newport and Bristol, Tenn., Executive Presbyter and Stated Clerk for Holston Presbytery, and as Director of Operations for the Office of the General Assembly under former Stated Clerk Clifton Kirkpatrick for seven years. He was first elected GA Stated Clerk in 2008 and his term ended in June 2016. Gradye is currently working on a book to address healthy pastors and their call. He and his wife, Kathy, have a son, Joshua and daughter, Rachel.

THE LEADERSHIP CALL TO 21ST CENTURY PASTORS - SanDawna Ashley. Twenty-first Century pastors foster collaboration, empower others to succeed, shape norms and provide vision through innovative solutions that look to the future while assessing the past. Participants will use the Book of Nehemiah to explore these themes and equip pastors for ministry today.

TEAMING WITH YOUR CLERGY - Stephen McCutchan. Elders and pastors building a team for a spiritually healthy church.

USING HUMOR TO COMBAT STRESS IN MINISTRY - Stephen McCutchan. How to turn your problems into punchlines and allow laughter to decrease the tension in your ministry.
